From a young age, Sarah has always wanted to make a positive contribution to her community. Her father was brought up in a large family in an Adelaide Housing Trust home where there was never enough money. He taught her the value of hard work and responsibility, to be grateful and appreciative, and to not expect anything from others.

Having achieved a 99.7 UAI (ATAR equivalent) in Year 12, Sarah chose veterinary medicine as a career. She completed her tertiary studies with First Class Honours. Not long after, she moved to the United Kingdom where she not only practised as a vet but later began a second career as a teacher.

Sarah's first teaching post was at a school marked for closure, where she taught children living in poverty and unsafe homes. Having attended five secondary schools herself and faced with disastrous outcomes as a young person (until an outstanding maths teacher gave her some hard truths), Sarah knows how influential passionate teachers can be. These experiences strengthened her belief that all children, no matter which school they attend, should be provided the same educational and employment opportunities.

Sarah returned to Adelaide in 2016, putting her career on hold to focus on raising her three young children before taking up veterinary practice again. Now, as a Member of the South Australian Parliament, Sarah is working hard to make a positive contribution to the South Australian community.

As a proud advocate for conservative family values, Sarah is committed to putting parents back in charge of their children's education and wellbeing, so they can guide their families according to their values and beliefs.

Sarah is also a strong advocate for men's health, recognising the unique societal pressures men face. She is the only sitting member dedicated to fighting for men's health and is passionate about awareness, support, and change.

Sarah believes every individual has the right to practise their culture and beliefs in a way that fosters a unified Australia. She opposes all race-based laws and firmly holds that all Australians should have equal rights under the law.

Highlights

- Secured funding to support the development of the Suicide Prevention Fellowship in Men's Mental Health at Flinders University.
- Saved SA's only RSL cemetery, the Port Lincoln Garden of Remembrance, after a grant supporting its maintenance ran out.
- Introduced the Voice Repeal Bill. Sarah remains the only sitting member to formally oppose race-based laws such as the "First Nations Voice to Parliament" and Nunga Courts.
- Introduced the Parental Primacy Bill, which emphasises parental primacy in the education of children, particularly regarding moral, ethical, political, social, and personal identity matters, including gender and sexuality.
- Introduced the Ministerial Travel Bill to mandate Ministers and Opposition leaders to publicly report detailed costs, purposes, and activities of official interstate and international travel within 45 days, ensuring transparency and accountability in the use of public funds.
- Introduced the Cash Payment Bill to keep cash as legal tender, forcing agencies – including SA councils – to accept cash payments for anything under \$10,000.
- Passed the Preventive Health SA (Council Governance) Amendment Bill to ensure members of the Preventive Health Council will not be compromised by Big Pharma, Big Food, Big Soda etc.
- The only Member of Parliament to oppose the government's expansion of emergency powers under the Emergency Management (Miscellaneous) Amendment Bill.

Men's Health

Across society, men face unique challenges that can impact their mental wellbeing, including societal pressures, stigma around expressing emotions, and inadequate mental health support tailored to their needs. I continue to advocate for greater funding in men's mental health, which has included:

Men's Health Checklist

I secured funding to develop the Men's Health Checklist (MHC). The MHC app aims to be a daily "checklist" that men can use to audit their day-to-day health, allowing doctors to use the information to provide better diagnoses, prescriptions and overall medical advice.

Suicide Prevention Fellowship

I secured significant funding to establish the Suicide Prevention Fellowship in Men's Mental Health, in collaboration with Breakthrough Mental Health Research Foundation and Flinders University.

International Men's Day

Since 2023, I have proudly hosted South Australia's largest International Men's Day event each year, celebrating the positive contributions men make to their families, communities, and the world, while raising vital funds for men's mental health. In 2024, I also successfully passed a motion in parliament recognising the importance of International Men's Day.

Unifying South Australia

I'm the only sitting member who has opposed all race-based laws.

The First Nations Voice legislation in South Australia was introduced – without any public consultation – before the national Voice referendum in October 2023, when over 64% of South Australians cast “NO” votes.

Even though most individuals opposed the Voice Referendum, the state administration moved forward with its state-based First Nations Voice.

I consider the SA Government's actions undemocratic, causing dispute and discord in South Australia.

As a result, I introduced the “Voice Repeal Bill”, which aims to remove South Australia's First Nations Voice entirely. This Bill looks to align the SA Government's policies with the democratic decisions made by not only South Australians but Australians nationwide.

By opposing the state-based Voice, I advocate for the preservation of democracy and ensuring the voices of South Australians are heard and respected – equally.

Freedom, Accountability & Transparency.

I introduced the Public Finance and Audit (Cash Payments) Amendment Bill 2024, which has now become the Public Finance and Audit (Cash Payments) Amendment Bill 2025, to protect financial freedoms and independence. It would forbid public authorities from refusing cash payments, guaranteeing that every Australian is allowed to pay up to \$10,000 in cash for government services.

This safeguards personal privacy, avoids certain expenses, and combats the growing trend of digital-only transactions that disproportionately affect rural communities.

I also introduced the Public Sector (Ministerial Travel Reports) Amendment Bill 2023, which was passed into law and is an important step towards increasing government accountability.

The Bill requires all ministers to record, itemise, and justify their travel expenses within 45 days, ensuring public funds are spent appropriately.

The Members of Parliament (Register of Interests) (Water Entitlements) Amendment Bill, which I introduced, passed the upper house in 2023. This Bill requires all South Australian MPs and their relatives to disclose all water ownership.

In 2025, I passed the Preventive Health SA (Council Governance) Amendment Bill to ensure members of the Preventive Health Council will not be compromised by Big Pharma, Big Food, Big Soda etc. The new legislation prevents anyone who gets paid by these 'interest' groups from sitting on the council.

My amendment also means the council must include members with hands-on, practical experience in preventive health.

Family Values

Stopping the ‘woke’ movement from harming our kids.

I recognise our society’s strength is dependent on the stability of its families. I aim to pass family-orientated legislation to address contemporary socio-cultural and educational challenges that harm the family unit and family values.

The Education and Children’s Services (Parental Primacy) Amendment Bill 2024 is a significant piece of legislation that aims to give parents more control over the education their children receive on issues of morality, ethics, politics, social values, personal wellbeing, and identity, including gender and sexuality.

Other measures I am implementing include:

- The Parental Alienating Behaviours Inquiry aims to address and mitigate harmful behaviours in family separations, as well as have these behaviours recognised as abuse in legislation and regulations.
- The “Loss of Foetus Bill” seeks justice for in-utero babies lost due to criminal acts.
- A strong pro-life stance, advocating for the protection of all life, including the unborn, and supporting policies that promote life-affirming choices and alternatives to abortion.

Affordability.

The rising cost of living is a serious issue for many South Australians, reducing their capacity to afford housing and basic necessities. To help alleviate this burden, I am advocating for broad legislative changes that make home ownership and daily living more affordable.

Before the SA Government's waiver of stamp duty for first-home buyers, I advocated for sweeping changes in residential stamp duty legislation.

My proposal sought reductions and exemptions to apply not only to first-home buyers of new homes but to first-home buyers of existing buildings and those downsizing.

I have also called for the immediate abolition of land tax in South Australia. I believe that removing this unnecessary tax burden will increase rental availability and affordability for SA's most vulnerable, help keep many struggling small businesses afloat, and drive investment in our state.

Lowering energy costs is a catalyst for lowering the cost of living, so my approach to energy is pragmatic and evidence-based. I seek tangible solutions that will reduce energy costs for all South Australians.

Veterans

Supporting those who have given the most.

Recognising the unique challenges our veterans face, I am dedicated to advocating for their specific needs and wellbeing. As part of my efforts, I established the first Parliamentary Friends of Veterans Group — a forum for veterans' organisations to help members of parliament better understand and address the issues affecting our veterans.

RSL Garden of Remembrance

I secured an SA Government grant for Port Lincoln's Garden of Remembrance, which is one of just three cemeteries nationwide managed by RSL Australia. This grant ensures the resting place for over 500 veterans is preserved and well-kept.

My advocacy for veterans includes:

Securing safe and stable housing.

Enhancing community connections.

Ensuring services for their mental health are available.

Providing financial security through improved employment opportunities.

I also advocate for timely access to affordable mental health care and robust support for veteran-specific assistance through a range of different services.

By focusing on the needs of veterans in South Australia, I hope to reduce the backlog of aid requests, improve mental health services for veterans, and enable smoother transitions into civilian life. I will continue to call on the government to provide the care and resources our veterans deserve.

Farmers

Backing Farmers and Cutting Red Tape

South Australian farmers regularly face tough droughts and harsh conditions, yet they continue to grow the food that sustains us all. We must make it easier, not harder, for them to get on with the job.

Right now, farmers are burdened with unnecessary red tape just to build small dams – under 5 megalitres and with walls under 3 metres. These dams are vital. They store water, support wildlife, aid in fire protection, and safeguard crops and livestock; yet, building these dams requires a drawn-out ‘Water Affecting Activity’ permit from the Landscape Board.

This process is slow, frustrating, and out of step with the unpredictable nature of farming. Farmers need to act quickly when the opportunity arises. That’s why I’m calling for the removal of this permit requirement for small dams.

It wouldn’t cost taxpayers a cent – but it would save jobs, protect livelihoods and strengthen our food security.

I will always back our mum and dad farmers. They are the backbone of our rural communities, and cutting this red tape is just one example of what I’m willing to do to support them. Protecting our foodbowl should never be a bureaucratic battle. Let’s trust farmers to manage their land – because they already do, every single day.
